

<b>Yarn:</b>	Knit Picks Sugarbunny yarn (80% Merino Wool, 20% Angora; 136 yards/50g) : #25506 Platinum, 2 skeins or 160 yards
<b>Needles:</b>	Size 9 (5.5 mm) 40" circular needle
<b>Gauge:</b>	Gauge varies and is not crucial but approximately 10 stitches and 20 rows over 4"/10cm in pattern.
<b>Finished Measurements:</b>	Approximately 55" x 5.5"

### Directions:

Cast on 150 stitches.

- Rnd 1: Join and purl round
- Rnd 2: Knit round
- Rnd 3: Purl round with 3 yarn wraps for each stitch
- Rnd 4: Knit round dropping 2 extra yarn wraps
- Rnd 5: Purl round
- Rnd 6: Knit round
- Rnd 7: Purl round with 3 yarn wraps for each stitch
- Rnd 8: Knit round dropping 2 extra yarn wraps
- Rnd 9: Purl round
- Rnd 10: Knit round
- Rnd 11: Purl round
- Rnd 12: Knit round
- Rnd 13: Purl round with 2 yarn wraps for each stitch
- Rnd 14: Knit round dropping 1 extra yarn wrap
- Rnd 15: Purl round
- Rnd 16: Knit round
- Rnd 17: Purl round
- Rnd 18: Knit round
- Rnd 19: Purl round with 3 yarn wraps for each stitch
- Rnd 20: Knit round dropping 2 extra yarn wraps
- Rnd 21: Purl round
- Rnd 22: Knit round
- Rnd 23: Purl round with 3 yarn wraps for each stitch
- Rnd 24: Knit round dropping 2 extra yarn wraps
- Rnd 25: Purl round

Bind off very loosely and weave in all ends.



### Drop Stitch Technique:

The drop stitch look is achieved by making elongated stitches across two rounds. The first round adds extra yarn wraps for each knit/purl stitch and the second round drops these extra yarn wraps.
